The Nassau County Police Department are looking to hire Police Medics! Nassau County Police Medics are the primary providers of pre-hospital emergency care for the County of Nassau.

POLICE MEDIC RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Responding to emergencies that originate via the Nassau County 911 system
- Providing pre-hospital care to patients both on scene and enroute to the hospital. This care includes IV therapy, defibrillation, medication administration, endotracheal intubation, and other medical techniques consistent with Nassau County Protocol.
- Proper documentation of patient care.
- Transfer of patient care, and report to hospital emergency departments.
- Maintenance and restocking of the Ambulance in preparation for other assignments.



Nassau County Police Medics are required to recertify every three years as per NYS guidelines. Recertification is provided as part of employment.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

Prior Pre-hospital care experience is preferred and recommended.

- High School Diploma
- Continuing possession of a valid NYS Driver's License.
- Continuing certification as a NYS EMT-CC or higher.
- Continuing certification as a Nassau County ALS Provider as per Nassau County credentialing process.
- Three years satisfactory experience as an operator of emergency vehicles.
- Preferential consideration given to applicants that are Nassau County residents. Suffolk and Queens residents are encouraged to apply.

★ Successful completion of the mandatory Emergency Vehicle Operators course given after appointment may be substituted for driving experience.

SALARY AND BENEFITS:

Appointment Salary	Grade 12, Step OA - \$38,479
6 Month Step Increase	Grade 12, Step OB - \$43,903
One Year Step Increase	Grade 12, Step 01 - \$52,059
Top Step	Grade 12 - \$87,892

Vacation:

- After 6 months you receive 5 vacation days/After 6 more months you receive 5 additional vacation days
- Then .5 vacation every two weeks up to 11 days per year for first to second year. After 2nd year you can earn up to 13 vacation days per year

Personal:

- After 6 months you receive 3 personal days
- After 2 years you receive 4 personal days
- After 3 years and every year thereafter you receive 5 personal days

Sick:

- From start date, .5 sick days every two weeks not to exceed 10 sick days per year for the first three years.
- Upon completion of three years, you can earn up to 13 days per year.

Health:

Contributory and non-contributory health plans.

Other:

- Contributory Pension Plan
- ★ Tax deferred savings plan through Prudential
